THERAPEUTIC IMPORTANCE OF ERANDA (*Ricinus communis* Linn.) IN AYURVEDA - A REVIEW

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Abstract

Ayurveda delineates the use of Eranda (*Ricinus communis* Linn., Euphorbiaceae) for the management of different disease conditions in Classical texts. In this article, an attempt has been made to compile as critically and its informations related to Eranda from six samhitas, seven samgraha granthas, nine nighantus and seven other published texts. It is observed that root, root bark, leaves, seed, oil of Eranda are used as an ingredient in 357 formulations, which are effective in more than 45 disease conditions. The main indications include vatavyadhi (diseases of joints), aamavata (rheumatoid artharitis), vrana (wound), agnimandya (loss of appetite), jvara (fever), grahani (Irritable bowel syndrome), shirogoga (disease of head), Shotha (inflammation), gandamala (lymphadenitis), hikka (hiccough), kushta (skin disease), visarpa (erysipelas), arsha (piles) etc. Different parts of Eranda are used in about 16 dosage forms; such as svarasa (juice), kvatha (decoction), lepa (paste), varti (suppository), avaleha (semi-solid preparations), taila (oil), rasa (mineral preparation), rasakriya (water extract), vati (pills), kshara (alkaline preparations), modaka (solid dosage form), ghrita (fat soluble preparations), churna (powder), dhupa (fumigating preparation), nasya (nasal preparations) and aschyotana (eye drops).

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INTRODUCTION

Ayurveda deals with drugs of plant, animal, metal and mineral origin, where maximum drugs are of plant origin.^[1] Information pertaining these drugs are available in the classical texts of Ayurveda named as Vedas (6000 BC), Samhitas (1500 BC – 600 AD), Nighantu and Samgraha granthas (800AD – 1900AD).^[2] Eranda, one of the classical drugs of herbal origin, botanically identified as *Ricinus communis* Linn, has been used by the Ayurvedic physicians, for the management of different disease conditions.

R. communis Linn., an annual or perennial bush or occasionally a soft wooded small tree up to 6 m. or more, found nearly throughout India, mostly under cultivation up to an elevation of 2000 m. It is widely cultivated in the tropics and warm regions for its seeds, which yield the well known castor oil. The castor is one of the major oilseed crops of India and in fact, India is the second largest producer of castor seed (c. 110,000 tons per annum) in the world.^[3]

Texts of Ayurveda, systematically recorded the varieties, synonyms, part used, pharmacological properties, actions and indications of Eranda in the respective texts, in their style of presentation. Its use, as an ingredient of compound formulations is recorded in samhitas (treatise) as well as in samgraha granthas (compendia of Ayurveda). On review it is observed that no single hand information is available regarding the uses and indications of Eranda as delineated in classical texts of Ayurveda. Hence, in this article, an attempt has been made to present the same.

MATERIAL AND METHODS

Various available samhitas (classical texts), nighantus (lexicons), samgraha granthas (compendia) and some other texts related to prayoga were referred; the synonyms,

properties, actions and various formulations with their adhikara (prime indication) were compiled, critically analyzed and arranged in a systematic manner.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Ayurvedic lexicon describes the plant drug through paryaya (synonyms). On the basis of reported synonyms, it is observed that Eranda is of two varieties i.e. Sweta (white) and Rakta (red). Sweta Eranda and Rakta Eranda were attributed 49 and 40 synonyms respectively, for describing its morphological and pharmacological characters, in various texts. (Table 1 and 2)

Synonyms attributed to Sweta Eranda indicate that it is very renowned plant, a soft shrub like small tree, with hollow cavity, grows vigorously. Leaves resemble to five fingers with five lobed, like hand of Gandharva (demigod), spreading in upward direction and have long petiole. Its inflorescence seems to be dancing and look alike the tail of a Tiger. Flower with less attraction. Fruits contain three compartments, with three numbers of seeds, which are variegated, distinguished, bright colored, spotted with oily matter. It has root without pith. (Table 1)

Synonyms of Rakta Eranda indicate it as a renowned plant, red in color with hanging down trunk. Leaves are broad, facing upward, resembles to ear of an elephant and are having five lobbed. Inflorescence, red in color with resemble to the tail of a Tiger. Fruit bears three numbers of variegated oil yeilding seeds. Eranda increases digestion, acts on Vatavyadhis (diseases of joints) and its action lasts for long time. (Table 2) One more variety, Sthula Eranda is delineated in Raja Nighantu. The synonyms attributed to Sthula Eranda are maha Eranda, maha panhcangula, which literally means bigger in size. Pharmacologically Sthula Eranda is more potential one.^[4]

Classification

Classical texts of Ayurveda mentions Eranda under different categories by keeping the drug under various vargas (groups of drugs) like Bhedaniya (purgatives),^[18] Angamarda prashamana (restorative),^[19] Swedopaga (helping in perspiration).^[20]

Madhuraskandha (sweet taste),^[21] Adhobhaghara (removes doshas from lower parts of body),^[23] Vatashamsaman (pacifying vata),^[24] Vidarigandhadi (begin with Vidarigandha i.e *Desmodium gangeticum* DC).^[22, 25]

Pharmacological properties of Eranda

Eranda has been attributed with madhura-katu-kashaya rasa, madhura vipaka and ushna virya; has guru, snigdha, tikshna and suksma gunas. It pacifies kapha-vata doshas. (Table 3)

It is being recommended to alleviate various disease conditions like Shula (pain), shoth (inflammation), gulma (abdominal lump), arsha (piles), jwara (fever), vatakaphaoada (distention of abdomen due to vata and kapha dosas), yakritpleehavriddhi (hepatosplenomegaly), krimi (worms), amavata (rheumatoid arthritis), katishula (lower backache), sirashula (headache), bastishula (pain in urinary bladder), kasa (cough), swasa (asthma), mutrakriccha (dysuria), carmavikara (skin disorders), vridhhi (enlargement of scrotum), kustha (skin diseases), vatavyadhis (diseases of joints), sukra (disorders of semen etc. (Table 3)

Eranda in classical text

The plant is being quoted 14 times, under different context, in Charaka samhita (CS). As an ingredient in angamardaprashtaman mahakashaya gana, bhedaniya gana, krumighna mahakashaya gana, swedopaga mahakashaya gana, formulations like agni

rasa, agurvadi taila, amrutadi taila, bramha rasayana, ikswaku taila, jeevaneeya ghrita, kanakkshira taila, pathyadi modaka, panda taila and trirutadi mishraka sneha (Table 4).

In Shusruta samhita, Eranda quated 04 times under vidarigandhadigana, as an ingredient of erandadi yoga, ksharagada and patralavanam.

Eranda is used as an ingredient in many formulations during samhita period. It is used as a drug in various formulations of Charakasamhita (14 – times), Sushrutasamhita (04 – times), Ashtangahrudaya (09 - times), Sharngadhara samhita (13 - times) and Bhavaprakasha (21 - times) (Table 4).

Samgraha granthas (different pharmacopoeia) of Ayurveda reports about 357 formulations having Eranda as an ingredient (Table 4). It is used, both internally (279) as well as externally (78), in various dosage forms such as svarasa (expressed juice), kvatha (decoction), kshira (milk preparation), churna (powder), taila (oil), ghruta (ghee), avaleha (confectionaries), dhupa (fumigation), lepa (paste), varti (suppositories), rasa, vati (tablet), kshara (alkali), modaka (solid dosage forms), rasakriya (water extract) and nasya (nasal drops) (Table 4).

It is observed that Eranda has been used as an ingredient of 357 formulations comprising of 279 internal and 78 external formulations. It is also one of the dravya of vidarigandhadi gana in Sushrutasmitha. In external application, the formulations are indicated for arsha (piles), bhagandara (fistula), netraroga (eye diseases), jwara (fever), karnapurana

(pouring liquid in ear), palitya (early graying of hair), krumi (worms), kushtha (skin diseases), shiroroga (disease of head), Shotha (inflammation), gandamala (lymphadenitis), vatavyadhi (diseases of joints), shlipada (filariasis), vruddhi (enlargement of scrotum), shula (pain), amavata (rheumatoid arthritis), visphotaka (blisterious eruption), vishroga (disorder

due to poison), vatarakta (gout), balaroga (disease of children), striroga (gynecological disorder), gulma (abdominal lump), visarpa (erysepales) and vrana (wound).

Formulations indicated for internal administration disease condition like sannipata (vitiation of all Dosas), arsha (piles), grahani (intestinal disorders), hikka (hiccough), kasa (cough), jwara (fever), kshaya (pulmonary tuberculosis), kushtha (skin diseases), mukharoga (oral diseases), shula (pain), sarpavisha (snake bite), striroga (gynecological disorders), vatarakta (gout), rasayana (rejuvenating agent), ashmari (kidney stone), aamvata (rheumatoid artharitis), amlapitta (acidity), gulma (abdominal tumor), karnaroga (disease of ear), mutrakruchcha (dysuria), kamla (jaundice), shlipada (filariasis), vrana (wound), unmad (insanity), malavrodha (constipation), vidradhi (abscess), udararoga (disease of stomach), hrudroga (heart disease), apasmar (epilepsy), krumi (worms), swarbheda (change of voice), atisara (diarrhoea), rajyakshama (tuberculosis), agnimadhyha (loss of appetite), raktapitta (bleeding disorder), raktsrava (haemorrhage), visarpa (erysepales), vruddhi (enlargement of scrotum) and vatavyadhi (diseases of joints).

Highest number of formulations was found in vatavyadhi (64), followed by shula (42), aamavata (28), gulma (15), jwara (14) and vatarakta (11) (Table 4).

It is also observed that root of Eranda is being used in highest number of formulations (212), followed by oil (90), Leaves (26), seed (25), panchanga (02) and fruits (01).

Dose

Root bark paste – 3g to 6g; Root decoction – 50ml to 100ml; Juice – 10ml to 20ml; Leave juice – 10ml to 20ml; Leave powder – 1g to 6g; Seed – 2 to 6 in numbers; Oil – 20ml to 40ml. [35]

Formulations of Eranda

Various sangraha granthas (compendias) were scrutinized for the formulations containing Eranda as an ingredient and mentioned in Table 4.

CONCLUSION

Eranda (*Ricinus communis* Linn.) is found throughout India and its description can be traced since Samhita period. Mainly two varieties of Eranda are found in various nighantus i.e. sweta eranda and rakta eranda. Eranda is attributed with pharmacological properties i.e madhura, katu, kashaya rasa; madhura vipaka and ushna virya; and useful to combat various disease conditions such as vatavyadhis (mainly various joint diseases and rheumatoid arthritis), inflammation, gout, fever, pain and skin diseases etc. It is used in more than 357 classical formulations, more than 16 dosage forms, used in about 45 diseased conditions, 78 external and 279 internally used.

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
